The students are given a budget and they must decide what to do, where to eat, where to play and how much shopping they want to do.

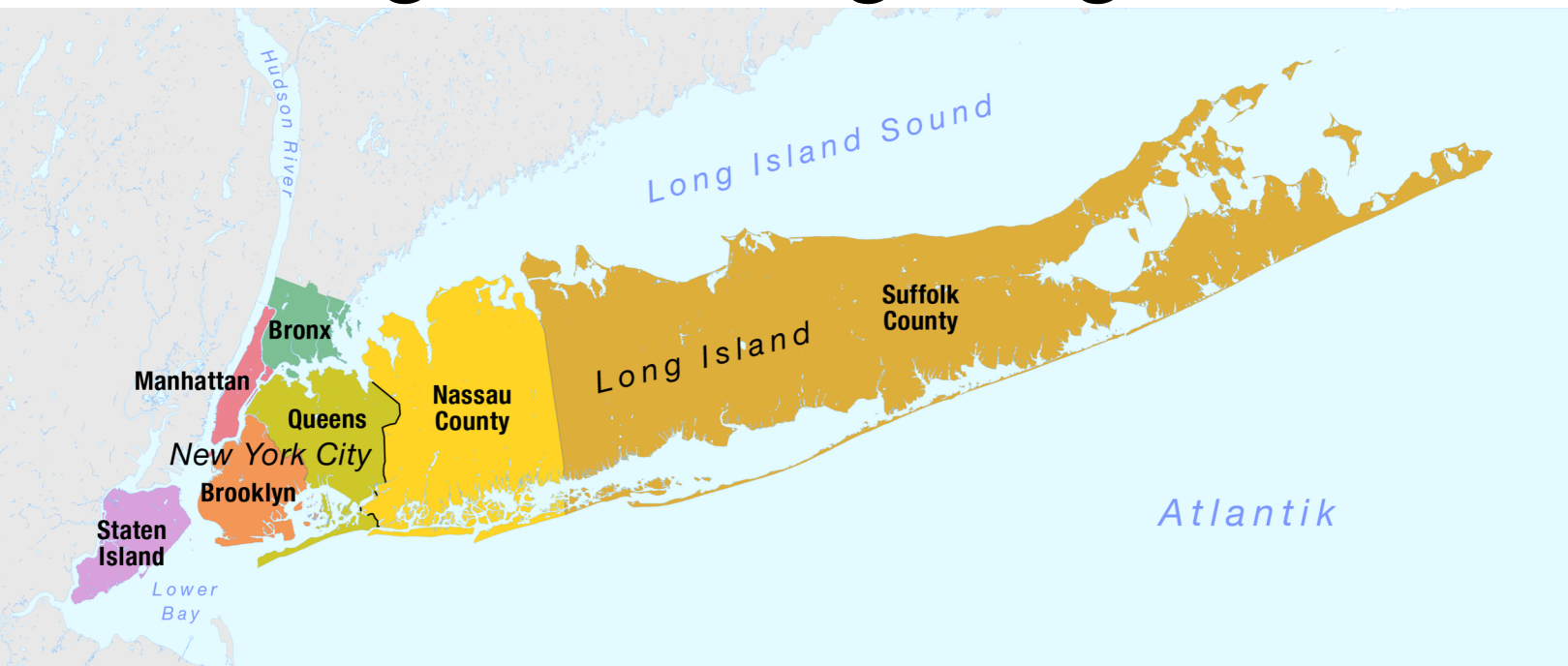

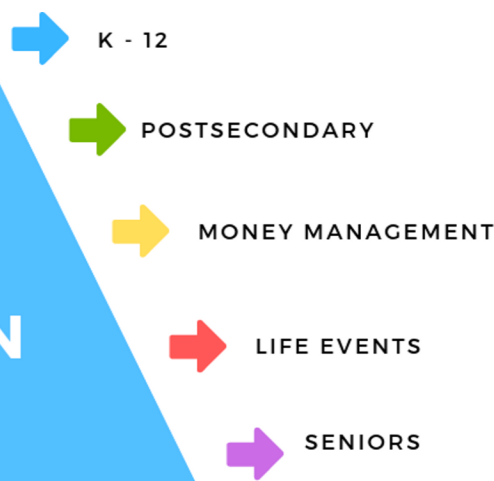
