Using fine motor skills and following simple directions, your students will prepare apples for crushing in our cider press. Pairs of children will take turns at the press to squeeze out the cider.

Students will also compare and contrast various types of apples and life today to earlier times.

Program Logistics:

- Outdoor area with easy vehicle access. If indoors, ground floor location with minimal stairs into building.
- Water source for rinsing press between sessions and large trash bin. Mop if programs is indoors.
- Tables or desks moved to create work stations.
- Adult parent assistance recommended
- Pre-trip materials are provided
