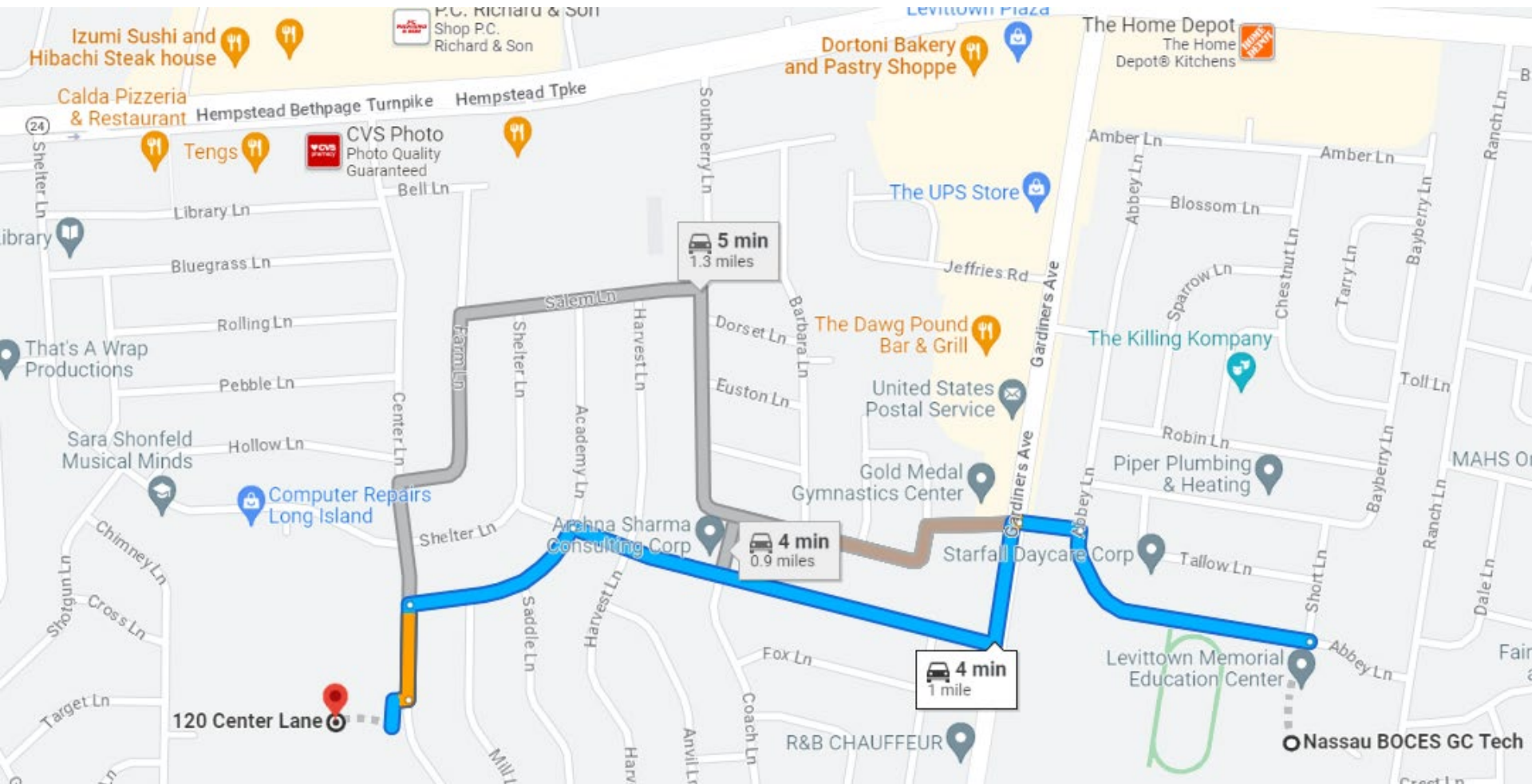

Automotive Technology

- The day after you graduate, you can go to the DMV and sign up to be licensed to be a NYS Inspector. [New York DMV | How to become a certified motor vehicle inspector \(ny.gov\)](#)
- Your ASE Student certifications are valid for 2 years
- If you are attending a training center (Ohio Technical, Lincoln Tech etc) you can use your Snap-On account for a *significant* discount on tools.
- Keep your OSHA certification and resume in a safe place!



EMT

To receive your 6 college credits, go to <http://veebems.org>. Download the transcript request form and give to your college admissions office. If you have not completed the EMT certification course, you must complete it within one year of graduation. To be eligible for the 6 credits you MUST pass your state EMT exam.

EMT –certification lasts for 3 years – if you keep up with your CMEs you do not need to retake

Must have a minimum "B" average (3.0 GPA) at Barry Tech.
Must have a minimum of "B" average (3.0 GPA) in high school.

Certificate of Completion.

Must be approved by instructor.

Attendance - minimum 85%

Student must complete application for advanced standing.

SUNY Alfred

BLCT 1202 - Portable Tools and Fastening Systems = 2 credits

BLCT 1222 - Construction Math = 2 credits

BLCT 3423 - Pipe Fitting - Math Estimating = 3 credits

BLCT 3456 - Plumbing Trade History and Safety = 3 credits

Must meet Alfred State's admission requirements and matriculate into the curriculum.

Must maintain an 85% average or better within their program's curriculum.

Must submit a completed course Proficiency Profile to SUNY Alfred department chair by first week of classes, along with a letter of recommendation from their technology instructor.

Must get an 85% or better on test by SUNY Alfred for each eligible course; student is responsible for scheduling test the week before classes begin.

Electrical Training Center

Enter into a 600 hour program within 2 years of high school graduation

Must have school diploma

Must complete a 2 year certificate program

Must have 80% minimum grade point average

Recommendation letter from a guidance counselor

Medical Assisting

- Your CHP provisional certification expires after 2 years.
- You must upgrade your certification before it expires by following the steps provided on the Certified Health Professionals Website.

Police Science

- Please keep your certification paperwork in a safe place to give to employers.
- Emergency Medical Responder – expires after 2 years
- Security Certification – must be renewed once you begin your first security job
