Why this is important?

This session will be the **first mandatory step** in accessing and applying for services. OPWDD provides supports and services to people who have developmental disabilities.

Information about OPWDD services

- Services are free and available starting at age 3.
- Services help people with disabilities live more independent and meaningful lives.
- Your child may qualify for a Medicaid waiver that allows them to receive these services regardless of family income and other health insurance.

Some available services include:

- Care Coordination
- Behavior Management
- Community Habilitation
- Respite
- Day Habilitation
