- 4 6 telehealth visits during school day focused on assessment, patient activation and self modulation
- Referred back to school counselor for monitoring and reassessment or referred to community resources for continued care

- \$750 per 1 hr webinar

- Custom webinars/education dependent on content, time and participation

Group Therapy
