

## **What is the Parent Dashboard?**

The New York State Education Department (NYSED) is developing a resource to increase transparency and make information about school performance and other school-level data more accessible to parents and the public. This is part of New York's ESSA plan.

The Parent Dashboard will feature a clean, simple design to better meet the needs of New York's parents and the public.

NYSED is gathering feedback from parents and stakeholders to guide the work of developing the Parent Dashboard. NYSED will use this feedback to identify the data that is most useful to parents and the public.

NYSED aims to launch a working draft of the Parent Dashboard in late spring 2019. Continuous stakeholder feedback will guide the development of the final product.
