

Statewide Computer-Based Testing (CBT) Simulation

The Statewide CBT Simulation provides the opportunity for an organized simulation with other schools throughout the State participating in 2021-22 operational CBT. The CBT Simulation offers the opportunity for school staff to evaluate the readiness of the school's internal systems, hardware, and school testing procedures for CBT. Student answers will not be scored after the simulation test is submitted, but the responses are transmitted to the Questar database, allowing the Secure Browser to confirm connection to the Questar database for the student's testing device.

The following checklist is for your use and will help you to prepare staff and students in your school to participate in New York State's CBT Simulation. You may retain this checklist for your use.

5	<p>Prepare Proctors</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Distribute student login tickets to proctors <input type="checkbox"/> Distribute the Session Access Code to proctors <input type="checkbox"/> Distribute the Proctor PIN to proctors <input type="checkbox"/> Confirm proctors know how to launch the Questar Secure Browser <input type="checkbox"/> Provide information about the Nextera Test Delivery System, available in the CBT Teacher's Directions
6	<p>Start the CBT Simulation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Hand out student login tickets <input type="checkbox"/> Have students launch the Questar Secure Browser and log in <input type="checkbox"/> Assist students with navigating through the online test directions <input type="checkbox"/> Students type in the Session Access Code <input type="checkbox"/> Students start the test <input type="checkbox"/> Students finish the test, click "Review," and then "Submit" the test <input type="checkbox"/> Proctors provide the Proctor PIN to students who need to pause during the Simulation
